

Swedish Sculptors' Association 40-Year Jubilee

The Swedish Sculptors' Association has turned 40. A warm welcome to our exhibitions, which will take place all around Sweden during 2015.

Sculpture in the public sphere is important, not least for making our society more exciting. It describes us and our times, it asks questions and encourages us to reflect.

The Swedish Sculptors' Association wants to arouse interest in today's many-faceted means of expression, materials and methods and expand our contacts with the world around us. We want to engage in the ongoing debate on urban development and the role of sculpture in public spaces.

A central exhibition will take place 10 July – 14 August in beautiful, historical Konstnärshuset at Smålandsgatan 7 in Stockholm. Some 90 sculptors will show their work under the theme TOUCH, which with its double meaning underlines the character of sculpture, a symbiosis of inner sensibility and tactile experience.

The program during the exhibition will have a number of stimulating features, including the following:

- Aspects of the creative process – to follow in film.
- Performances that visualize relationships between our bodies and sculptures/objects.
- Workshops where children, young people and adults can try out working with form, in traditional ways and even digitally.
- Guided tours in various languages, as well as special tours by appointment for visitors with physical limitations or visual impairment.
